## SAFE ZONE

<b>80 dB</b>	City Traffic
<b>70 dB</b>	Small Party
<b>60 dB</b>	Normal Speaking Voice
<b>50 dB</b>	Car Horn
<b>40 dB</b>	Refrigerator Motor
<b>30 dB</b>	Whisper
<b>20 dB</b>	Rustling Leaves
<b>10 dB</b>	Normal Breathing
<b>0 dB</b>	Threshold of Normal Hearing
